

#### NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

#### **Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time** June 25, 2023

Advertisements in our society today charm us with their mesmerizing words. But the reminders of Jesus in the gospel focus us to what journey we will take to be connected always with him, he said: "... whoever does not take up his cross and follow me is not worthy of me. Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it..." The reminders of Jesus might be understood with this story:

A Master summoned two of his disciples and gave each one a cross of the same weight. He asked them to carry them up to the end of the road, where he would wait for them. The first disciple carried the cross with ease, while the second disciple lagged behind, obviously having a hard time. After reaching the end of the road, the first disciple handed the cross to his master. The master told him, "Well, done, my son!"

The second disciple reached the end of the road two days after the first one arrived. When he got there, he threw the cross at his master's feet, complaining, "It is not fair! You gave me a heavier cross; that is why it took me longer to get here!" The master answered, "Son, both the crosses are of the same weight." But the second disciple continued to complain, "But how come I carried mine with much difficulty while he carried his with ease?" The master replied, "The problem was not the cross but your attitude. Your every complaint only added to the weight of the cross. The first disciple carried his cross with no difficulty because every loving thought of me diminished the weight of his cross."

For us CHRISTIANS, our attitude would be to CARRY THE CROSS OF CHRIST with LOVE not with complaints and whining. We have to engage ourselves in a loving Christian activity that fosters unity instead of division; compassion instead of hate, welcome instead of rejection, and inclusion rather than exclusion. If we genuinely follow Christ without counting the cost, our identity as disciples of Jesus can be recognized by others in an encounter like this: "Why is it that every time I see you, I can see Christ?" And our answer will be, "It is the Christ in you that recognizes the Christ in me".

Today, struggle to be Christ-like...


