# NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR Seventh Sunday of Easter - Year B May 12, 2024

Many people are wondering why Ascension Thursday was transferred to Ascension Sunday throughout most of the country... (with the exception of the dioceses in Nebraska and an East Coast diocese.) Well, this is the history, please read with the lens of your faith:

In December 1993, the Vatican granted an indult to the dioceses of the ecclesiastical provinces of Los Angeles, San Francisco, Portland in Oregon, Seattle, and Anchorage to transfer the Ascension Thursday to the Seventh Sunday of Easter. The provision was made on an experimental basis for a period of five years. The general motivation was to increase public participation in the celebration of the Ascension. And in 1998, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops approved a procedure (confirmed by Rome) to allow each ecclesiastical province to determine whether or not to make the change permanent. By a count made in 2000, most of the provinces made the change with the exception of the three Nebraska dioceses and one on the East Coast.

ASCENSION is the graced moment when the ministry and mission of Jesus are passed on into our hearts. He said to his disciples and all of humanity today: "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved..."

Those words engage us to become the ambassadors of Christ. As the gospel says, "in his name we can drive out demons, we will speak new languages, we can pick up serpents with our hands, and when we will lay our hands to those who are sick they will recover." We cannot just keep to ourselves the good news we have received.

ASCENSION challenges us to work double time to put JESUS back into the center of our lives, because in him: "whatever the question, HE is the answer; whatever the problem, HE is the solution; whatever the hurt, HE is the healer; whatever the need, HE is the supplier; whatever the sin, HE is the forgiver."

And today, at this very minute, let the work and witnessing begin... whether we celebrate the Ascension on Thursday or Sunday!


