James 2:14–17 (ESV)

“What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him? ¹⁵If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, ¹⁶and one of you says to them, ‘Go in peace, be warmed and filled,’ without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that? ¹⁷So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.”

Faith has to always look like something or as James said it is likely dead. A vibrant faith will likely result in a life that is stewarded for the glory of God especially in the work of His church. We will, by the grace of God, work together to train, equip, challenge, and encourage each other to courageously use all that God has given to us in a way that demonstrates that the wisdom of God has penetrated our hearts and minds.
