Georgia Law

If a transferring middle/high school student does not bring a certified copy of his/her academic transcript and disciplinary record from the school previously attended by the student, Georgia Law (O.C.G.A.20-2-670) provides....."a transferring student may be admitted on a conditional basis if he/she and his/her parent or legal guardian executes a document providing the name and address of the school last attended and authorizing the release of all academic and disciplinary records to the school administration.".....and....."shall also disclose on the same document as the release whether the child has even been adjudicated guilty of the commission of a designated felony act as defined in Code Section 15-11-63 and, if so, the date of such adjudication, the offense committed, the Jurisdiction in which such adjudication was made, and the sentence imposed..... (A list of designated felony acts is attached hereto.) The student or his/her parent or legal guardian shall also disclose on the document whether the student is currently serving a suspension or expulsion from another school, the reason for such discipline, and the term of such discipline. If a student so conditionally admitted is found to be ineligible for enrollment pursuant to the provisions of Code Section 20-2-752, or is subsequently found to be so ineligible, he/she shall be dismissed from enrollment until such time as he/she becomes eligible."

DESIGNATED FELONY ACTS

1. A second or subsequent conviction for possession of a handgun where the child is between the ages of 13 and 17;
2. Kidnapping or arson in the first degree
3. Aggravated assault, arson in the second degree, aggravated battery, robbery, armed robbery not involving a firearm, or battery on a teacher or other school personnel;
4. Attempted murder or Attempted kidnapping
5. Hijacking a motor vehicle;
6. Possession of a destructive device, distribution of a destructive device, explosive, poison gas, or detonator or conspiracy to commit the aforementioned offenses;
7. The sale or manufacture of certain controlled substances relating to trafficking of cocaine, illegal drugs, marijuana, or meth;
8. Racketeering
9. Escape
10. Smash or grab burglary;
11. Any other act which, if done by an adult, would be a felony, if the child committing the act has three times previously been adjudicated delinquent for acts which, if done by an adult, would have been felonies;
