

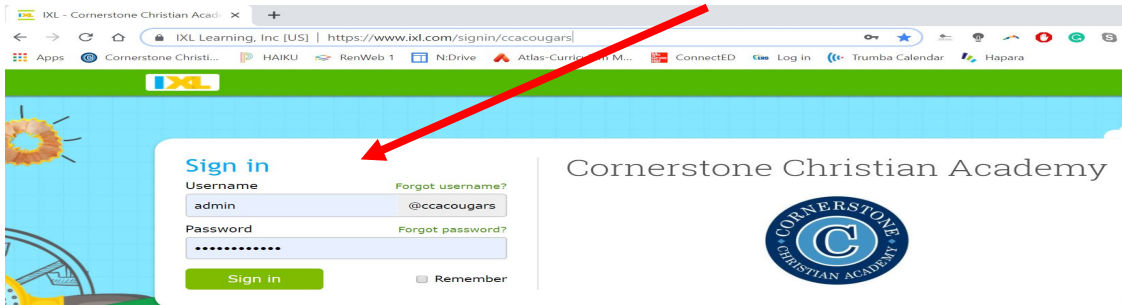

## HONORS 8<sup>th</sup> Grade - Summer Math & Language Arts Work

To get started on a home computer, please follow these easy steps:

1. Go to <https://www.ixl.com/signin/ccacougars> to log in



3. Enter the assigned username and password and select the arrow. (Note: Returning students should use their current log in information. NEW FAMILIES - log in information for each child was sent to the parent email addresses on file in ParentsWeb).
4. Use the chart below to complete the IXL summer math and language arts assignments.
5. Navigate to your level and section. **Only move to a new section when you have reached, at least, an 80% Smart Score.** Once you reach 80% in one section, move to another section.
6. To start the school year, all students will take a review assessment based on the IXL summer exercises. If a student scores below an 80%, the student may need to attend Friday Study Hall in place of recess for four weeks to work on assigned concepts. This is to ensure a solid foundation for the current year.
