

# ORDINANCE

O-15-18

BOROUGH OF NORTH CALDWELL, ESSEX COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 99 "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", §99-10 "SCHEDULE VIII, STOP INTERSECTIONS", OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH CALDWELL TO ACCEPT A MULTI-WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF BEACHMONT TERRACE AND HAMILTON DRIVE EAST**

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the Borough of North Caldwell has determined that a multi-way stop sign be installed at the intersection of Beachmont Terrace and Hamilton Drive East in order to provide for the public safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Engineer has certified that the conditions established under N.J.S.A. 39:4-197(1)j have been met; and

**WHEREAS**, the desirability and feasibility of a multi-way stop at the intersection of Beachmont Terrace and Hamilton Drive East has been reviewed and recommended by both the Chief of Police and the Borough Engineer.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of North Caldwell, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

- Chapter 99, "Vehicles and Traffic", Section 99-10, "Schedule VIII, Stop Intersections", shall be amended to provide, as an additional multi-way stop intersection, the following:**


Schedule VIII, Stop Intersections

Beachmont Terrace and Hamilton Drive East	Beachmont Terrace and Hamilton Drive East (Multi-Way)


- All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
- This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
