BOROUGH OF NORTH CALDWELL, ESSEX COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH CALDWELL, COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 88, ARTICLE VI, ENTITLED "OPENING AND ACCEPTANCE OF STREETS"

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of North Caldwell wishes to protect life, public safety and all property throughout the Borough by ensuring the most appropriate fire protection equipment be installed; and

WHEREAS, it is essential to ensure the North Caldwell Volunteer Fire Department ("Department") is provided all equipment in accordance with the needs identified by the Department and essential to the Department to fulfill the emergency duties of the Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of North Caldwell, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. **Chapter 88. Streets and Sidewalks**, of the Borough of North Caldwell is amended and supplemented as stated below:

(All other subsection of Chapter 88 "Streets and Sidewalks" will remain unchanged.)

§88-41 Water mains and hydrants.

§88-41.C

Fire hydrants shall be "Super Centurion" as manufactured by Mueller Company, and shall be painted the prevailing color of other hydrants in the Borough. All hydrants shall also be equipped with a Storz connection on the front steamer and shall be subject to the review and approval by the Borough.

1. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
2. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
