ORDINANCE NO. O-5-16

AN ORDINANCE AMMENDING CHAPTERS
77-7A(1) AND 78-3B(1) OF THE
CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH
CALDWELL REGARDING THE
PLACEMENT OF RECEPTACLES AND
MATERIALS AT CURBSIDE

WHEREAS, The Governing Body of the Borough of North Caldwell has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the Borough of North Caldwell to create and maintain consistency between Section 77-7A(1) and Section 78-3(B)(1) of the Code of Borough of North Caldwell concerning the times at which bulk garbage receptacles and recycling receptacles may be placed at and retrieved from curbside pursuant to the Code of the Borough of North Caldwell;

NOW, THEREFORE, MAY IT BE ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of North Caldwell, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:


1. Section 77-7A(1) *Garbage and/or refuse*. Shall read as follows: No refuse, bulk waste, recyclable materials, bagged leaves or other materials which now or in the future may be mandated for curbside collection by the township or other solid waste collector under contract with the township may be placed at curbside for collection earlier than 7:00 p.m. of the day before the scheduled collection day, nor shall the garbage and/or refuse receptacle be permitted to remain in public view beyond 11:30 p.m. of the day collected. All materials placed at the curb for collection shall be located behind the curb or paved edge of the street toward the residence and shall not be placed on the paved portion of the street.
2. Section 78-3(B)(1) *Placement of Receptacles at Curbside; Penalty*. Shall read as follows: No receptacles or materials should be placed at curbside prior to 7:00 p.m. of the day before the scheduled collection day, nor shall the receptacle be permitted to remain in public view beyond 11:30 p.m. of the day collected.
3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
4. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
