Classes in the PCT program can be taken individually or together as part of the whole program.

Classes meet Monday, Wednesday, and Friday during the above listed dates.

Attendance is a priority, as lectures occur one time in a season and making up days can be quite difficult.

Phlebotomy typically runs for 6 weeks, EKG runs for 3 weeks and Advanced Nursing Skills for the Nurse Aide runs for 2 weeks. There is a week break between each program so that you may have enough time to study before taking the National Exams, usually scheduled for Fridays.
