Parade Rules & Regulations

To ensure a smooth and enjoyable event, please review the following rules and regulations carefully. Violations will result in ineligibility for participation in future motorized events.

1. Registration Deadline:

All entries must be registered by Monday, January 13, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. Use the link <https://mp.gg/6tdofy3> to complete registration.

2. Peaceful Procession:

The parade is intended to be a peaceful event. Loud music is prohibited along the parade route.

3. Decorations:

Participants are encouraged to tastefully decorate their cars, trucks, and other vehicles.

4. Safety for Passengers:

- No one may stand in the bed of a truck while the vehicle is in motion.
- If children are in the truck bed, they must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

5. Business and Corporate Signage:

Signs promoting businesses and corporations are welcome, provided they are appropriate for a family-friendly event.

6. Family-Friendly Conduct:

Any obscene, vulgar, or violent displays or behavior are strictly prohibited.

7. Distribution of Items:

No participant is allowed to distribute literature, gum, or candy from moving vehicles during the parade.

8. Formation Integrity:

No motor vehicle may break formation during the parade.

9. Vehicle Limits:

- Cars and motorcycle groups are limited to five vehicles per group.
- All vehicles within a group must line up simultaneously.
- Motorcycle groups must contact the committee in advance to confirm their numbers.

10. Constant Movement:

- The parade must maintain a steady pace.
- Stopping along the route to perform or for any other reason is not allowed.
- Participants must comply with requests to speed up, slow down, or close gaps to maintain formation.

11. Lineup Details:

- Lineup begins at 10:00 a.m. on January 20th (unless otherwise stated).
- The parade starts promptly at 10:30 a.m.
- Participants must enter at their designated entry point assigned by the parade committee.
- Late arrivals will be placed at the end of the lineup based on their time of arrival.

12. Updates and Communication:

- Updates will be posted on the website at www.templetxnaacp.org.
- Participants will also be notified via email if one is provided during registration.

13. Vehicle Safety and Compliance:

All motor vehicles must be deemed safe for operation and all drivers must adhere to these rules, regulations, and applicable laws before and during the parade.
