

Thanks for your financial faithfulness the year-to-date financial report shows a small loss (less than \$1,000) through September 30, 2020. Since the Covid-19 shut-down, non-pledge and loose plate income, primarily received during the Offertory, is affected because we have abandoned regular in-person services. Also eliminated is our facility use income.

As of October 28, the 2021 Pledge Campaign shows 26 pledge cards received totaling \$77,100. We are 71% toward our 2021 Budget Pledge Income. *Great is your faithfulness*.
