3. MY TAKE-AWAY

Lesson 6 – The Wisdom of the Magi Jan 7, 2024

Focal Passages: Proverbs 2:8-9 and Matthew 2:1-12

Purpose Statement: To Identify the Marks of True Wisdom in Our Discipleship Journey

In Matthew's account of the birth of Jesus we learn that the Magi, these **gentile** visitors from the East, "were filled with joy when they saw the star". By inspiration, they began a lengthy trip to Jerusalem, to come and honor the newborn king of the Jews. They arrived in Bethlehem when Jesus was a toddler and "falling on their knees, they honored him".

We might ask ourselves, how did these people from far-away lands know what was happening thousands of miles away and how did they know what it meant?

The Magi were educated people in science and astronomy, and they realized that something unusual was happening. Thet had the **knowledge** to notice that an unusual star was shining in the firmament. They knew by tradition that such occurrences meant something significant was happening. But this is as far as their **knowledge** can carry them. The inspiration to follow the star and to know what it meant could only come from God. This is how the Magi paints for us a picture of a true disciple. We can acquire knowledge from different sources: the Bible, prayer, preaching, and fellow Christians but all that accumulated knowledge is worthless without its proper application to our everyday life decisions. That is where **wisdom** comes in. Wisdom in a gift from God. How "wise" we are is therefore a reflection of how closely we listen to God and how in-tune we are with the promptings of his Holy Spirit.
