1. BLESSING BAGS FOR THE HOMELESS



Each bag is filled with simple items to help someone get through the day. Hygiene items, snacks, and inspirational materials are common blessing bag items. The items we collect during Lent will be used to assemble Blessing Bags at a Sunday Night Live event in April. The completed bags will be distributed throughout our community to help those in need.
