4. 2023 LENTEN BIBLE CHALLENGE

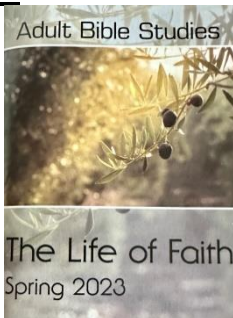


When: Feb 22 (Ash Wed) to April 8 (Sat) (40 days except Sundays)
