

BCUMC ENDOWMENT FUND

The Endowment Fund of Brentwood Community United Methodist Church received a very generous bequest from the estate of Vernon Noble. Before he passed away, Vernon designated Brentwood Community United Methodist Church a beneficiary of an annuity. Vernon's wishes were that the money was to be deposited in the Endowment Fund of BCUMC. We have complied with Vernon's wishes.

Vernon was on the committee that wrote the guidelines and created the Endowment Fund. The funds are in a special account managed by the California-Nevada United Methodist Foundation in Sacramento. Money deposited in the Endowment Fund is never to be spent; however, the interest generated can be used for special projects. Vernon did not put any 'strings' on how the interest generated by his bequest was to be used. The current practice is that interest earned by the Endowment Fund is deposited back into the Fund to help speed the growth of the Fund.




