COVENANT OF CONDUCT to be read & signed by youth and parent

In all meetings, retreats or other events under the sponsorship and/or guidance of the BCUMC Youth Group, I am a representative of that Christian community. I am responsible for my actions. I understand that the following *Covenant of Conduct* will be followed. **I understand failure to do so may result in a call to my parents, removal from event, and/or removal from youth program.**

- The use of violence, drugs, possession of weapons, lighters, alcohol and tobacco is strictly prohibited. Chaperones must be made aware of **any** drugs, including prescriptions subscribed to you by a doctor and over-the-counter medicine.
- All conduct shall be with regard and respect for all persons. Therefore no teasing, cursing, touching, arguing, rough-housing, and offensive language. This shall extend to any social networking postings.
- All individuals are expected to participate in all group activities and be fully engaged, on-time, and respectful to presenters and Chaperones.
- All dress shall meet specific camp/event guidelines. Revealing clothes and t-shirts with offensive slogans are not allowed and must be changed immediately.
- The areas used for meetings, retreats, games, etc. shall be left clean.
- All individual and group photos are to be respectful and not to include offensive body gestures or hand signs.
- The use of electronic devices such as cell phones, games, ipods, etc. is not permitted during group time. Three strikes rule applies.
- Chaperone guidelines for hugging and sleeping arrangement **must** be followed.
- Once checked in, participants may not drive to/from event locations.
- Participants must stay within designated areas as outlined for activity.
