

STAINED GLASS WINDOWS AT AGRACE OF GOD

Our stained glass windows were designed and constructed by members of Grace of God.
They were dedicated on Easter Sunday, 2010



The **first window** (top left) depicts Christ's presence among us through his Word and the Gospel of Christ it reveals.

In Scripture God promises: **"My word . . . will not return to me empty**, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it." Isaiah 55:11

The **second window** (top right) depicts Christ's presence among us through Baptism and the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Scripture says: "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." Acts 2:38

The **third window** (bottom left) depicts Christ's presence among through the Lord's Supper.

For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes." I Corinthians 11:26

The **fourth window** (bottom right) depicts a crown of glory and a crown of thorns – the crucified and risen Christ who is present for us in Word and Sacrament.

"For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God." Romans 6:9-10
