#### **Genesis 1:1-5**

1 In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. <sup>2</sup> The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. <sup>3</sup> And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. <sup>4</sup> And God saw that the light was good. And God separated the light from the darkness. <sup>5</sup> God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And there was evening and there was morning, the first day.



#### **Psalm 29**

29 Ascribe to the Lord, O heavenly beings, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength.

- <sup>2</sup> Ascribe to the Lord the glory due His name; worship the Lord in the splendor of holiness.
- <sup>3</sup> The voice of the Lord is over the waters; the God of glory thunders, the Lord, over many waters.
- <sup>4</sup> The voice of the Lord is powerful; the voice of the Lord is full of majesty.
- <sup>5</sup> The voice of the Lord breaks the cedars; the Lord breaks the cedars of Lebanon.
- <sup>6</sup> He makes Lebanon to skip like a calf, and Sirion like a young wild ox.
- <sup>7</sup> The voice of the Lord flashes forth flames of fire.
- <sup>8</sup> The voice of the Lord shakes the wilderness; the Lord shakes the wilderness of Kadesh.
- <sup>9</sup> The voice of the Lord makes the deer give birth and strips the forests bare, and in His temple all cry, "Glory!"
- <sup>10</sup> The Lord sits enthroned over the flood; the Lord sits enthroned as king forever.
- <sup>11</sup> May the Lord give strength to His people! May the Lord bless His people with peace!

#### Acts 19:1-7

19 And it happened that while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul passed through the inland country and came to Ephesus. There he found some disciples. <sup>2</sup> And he said to them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" And they said, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit." <sup>3</sup> And he said, "Into what then were you baptized?" They said, "Into John's baptism." <sup>4</sup> And Paul said, "John baptized with the baptism of repentance, telling the people to believe in the one who was to come after him, that is, Jesus." <sup>5</sup> On hearing this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. <sup>6</sup> And when Paul had laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they began speaking in tongues and prophesying. <sup>7</sup> There were about twelve men in all.



#### Mark 1:4-11

<sup>4</sup> John appeared, baptizing in the wilderness and proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. <sup>5</sup> And all the country of Judea and all Jerusalem were going out to him and were being baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins. <sup>6</sup> Now John was clothed with camel's hair and wore a leather belt around his waist and ate locusts and wild honey. <sup>7</sup> And he preached, saying, "After me comes he who is mightier than I, the strap of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie. <sup>8</sup> I have baptized you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit." <sup>9</sup> In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. <sup>10</sup> And when he came up out of the water, immediately he saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. <sup>11</sup> And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."
