#### Jeremiah 4:11-12, 22-28

<sup>11</sup> At that time it will be said to this people and to Jerusalem, "A hot wind from the bare heights in the desert toward the daughter of my people, not to winnow or cleanse, <sup>12</sup> a wind too full for this comes for me. Now it is I who speak in judgment upon them." <sup>22</sup> "For my people are foolish; they know me not; they are stupid children; they have no understanding. They are 'wise'—in doing evil! But how to do good they know not." <sup>23</sup> I looked on the earth, and behold, it was without form and void; and to the heavens, and they had no light. <sup>24</sup> I looked on the mountains, and behold, they were quaking, and all the hills moved to and fro. <sup>25</sup> I looked, and behold, there was no man, and all the birds of the air had fled. <sup>26</sup> I looked, and behold, the fruitful land was a desert, and all its cities were laid in ruins before the Lord, before his fierce anger. <sup>27</sup> For thus says the Lord, "The whole land shall be a desolation; yet I will not make a full end. <sup>28</sup> "For this the earth shall mourn, and the heavens above be dark; for I have spoken; I have purposed; I have not relented, nor will I turn back."

#### Psalm 14

14 The fool says in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, they do abominable deeds; there is none who does good.

<sup>2</sup> The Lord looks down from heaven on the children of man, to see if there are any who understand, who seek after God.

<sup>3</sup> They have all turned aside; together they have become corrupt; there is none who does good, not even one.

<sup>4</sup> Have they no knowledge, all the evildoers who eat up my people as they eat bread and do not call upon the Lord?


<sup>5</sup> There they are in great terror, for God is with the generation of the righteous.

<sup>7</sup> Oh, that salvation for Israel would come out of Zion! When the Lord restores the fortunes of his people, let Jacob rejoice, let Israel be glad.

#### 1 Timothy 1:12-17

<sup>12</sup> I thank him who has given me strength, Christ Jesus our Lord, because he judged me faithful, appointing me to his service, <sup>13</sup> though formerly I was a blasphemer, persecutor, and insolent opponent. But I received mercy because I had acted ignorantly in unbelief, <sup>14</sup> and the grace of our Lord overflowed for me with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. <sup>15</sup> The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am the foremost. <sup>16</sup> But I received mercy for this reason, that in me, as the foremost, Jesus Christ might display his perfect patience as an example to those who were to believe in him for eternal life. <sup>17</sup> To the King of the ages, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.



#### **Luke 15:1-10**

15 Now the tax collectors and sinners were all drawing near to hear him. <sup>2</sup> And the Pharisees and the scribes grumbled, saying, "This man receives sinners and eats with them." <sup>3</sup> So he told them this parable: <sup>4</sup> "What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he has lost one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the open country, and go after the one that is lost, until he finds it? <sup>5</sup> And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing. <sup>6</sup> And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and his neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep that was lost.' <sup>7</sup> Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance. <sup>8</sup> "Or what woman, having ten silver coins, if she loses one coin, does not light a lamp and sweep the house and seek diligently until she finds it? <sup>9</sup> And when she has found it, she calls together her friends and neighbors, saying, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found the coin that I had lost.' <sup>10</sup> Just so, I tell you, there is joy before the angels of God over one sinner who repents."
