Give all of us Your comfort when our hearts are troubled. We ask You to sustain all those who are persecuted on account of Jesus. Give wisdom and gentleness to their words and courage to their actions. This morning, we also ask You to be with all our friends and families on our prayer list and those whose names we speak out loud or say silently in our hearts.
