Write about what caused you to seek Christ, obstacles you may have encountered or are currently encountering, and people or situations that helped your faith develop. How has your relationship with Christ affected your life?
2. **Activities participated in at St. Paul’s UMC, or your college church or faith group:** Describe how you are involved in church activities or things you do to help out at your church, e.g., at the service or classes, serving food at church, cleaning up at church. In what ways have you been involved at St. Paul’s?
3. **Community service activities within the last two (2) years:** Describe how you are involved in activities in the community, school, or helping out a neighbor or person in your community, etc. Please explain so we can understand what you did.
4. **Goals after high school or current goals regarding the program or college you are attending:** What is the course of study or program that you have chosen to pursue? Why did you chose it? What would you like to accomplish?
5. **Extracurricular school and community activities within the last two (2) years:** Describe your involvement in school activities, college groups, singing groups, athletic groups or other school and community programs such as the Summer Park and Recreation programs.
6. **Paid or unpaid work experience within the last two (2) years:** Where have you worked and what did you do. What is your current job? How many hours per week? If you had an unpaid experience such as internship, job shadow, hospital volunteer or other type of unpaid work, please explain. Again provide how many hours were devoted to this?
