


THE WOODLOCH TOWN COUNCIL HELD A SPECIAL AGENDA MEETING ON FRIDAY JULY 3, 2021.  
Meeting started at 11:57 am @ 2651 SOUTH WOODLOCH (SEWER PLANT)

1. Call to Order by Mayor Leino
2. Opening prayer and Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America was led by Mayor Leino
3. Roll Call Present at the meeting were:  
Mayor, R. Leino Jr., Aldermen: G. Mink, C. Waddle, M. Greening, L. Kessner and Donald J. Nichols Quorum was established.
4. Citizen Comments – Not to Exceed 30 minutes (3 minutes per person) No comments on this meeting.
5. Presentation of current, past, and future projects relating to the Sewer Treatment Plant. Jason started the presentation by leading the council members to the plant and Mike Mathena asked for everyone to watch their steps as the plant is very old. Jason stated that the bugs in the sewer plant are brown, and that of course there was feces inside but the bugs turn brown as they are doing their job.

Mike Mathena proceeded to explain to council that the new plant is under construction. He showed the council members where the new plant is and walked the council through the plant. Mike Mathena let the council know that an estimated time for the new plant to be up and running would be by the end of the year. The old plant will be put off-line until it can be figured out what to do with it. The plant will be somewhat quieter but not by a lot, he was able to buy a quieter fan but not by much. A new generator has been ordered and will be set on the back of the new plant so the pad will have to be extended in order for the generator to fit. This generator will power the new plant. The new sewer treatment plant it is going to sit higher than the current sewage plant. It is going to be above the 100-year plan.
