NO. 28

ORDINANCE SETTING TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 1977

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended a tax rate of seventy-five (75¢) Cents on the one hundred dollar valuation of all property of every kind and character appearing on the Town of Whispering Oaks Tax Rolls for the year 1977, which is required to raise the funds needed for its Budget heretofore adopted, to be used for interest and sinking fund:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS, TEXAS:

THAT the tax rate be and the same is hereby set at seventy-five (75¢) Cents on the one hundred dollar valuation of all property of every kind and character placed on the Tax Rolls of the Town of Whispering Oaks, Texas, for the year 1977.
