

ORDINANCE

(Motion was made by Bruce Bell, seconded by Dallas Hunt, that the following Ordinance be passed:)

ORDINANCE NO. 84-2

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND LEVYING MUNICIPAL AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS FOR THE YEAR 1984 AND FOR EACH YEAR THEREAFTER UNTIL OTHERWISE PROVIDED; AND DIRECTING THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the tax for the year 1984, hereinafter levied for current expenses of the Town and the general improvements of the Town and its property must be levied to provide the revenues required for the budget of the ensuing year; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council further finds that the taxes for the year 1984, hereinafter levied therefor are necessary for municipal purposes during the ensuing year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS:

SECTION I:

For the current expenses of the Town of Woodloch, Texas, and for the general improvement and welfare of the Town, there is hereby levied and ordered to be assessed and collected for the year 1984, and for each year thereafter until it be otherwise provided and ordained on all property situated within the limits of the Town of Woodloch, Texas, and not exempt from taxation by valid laws, an ad valorem tax at the rate of \$.43 on the \$100.00 evaluation of such property.
