(Motion was made by John Richards and seconded by James Lout that the following Ordinance be passed:)

ORDINANCE NO. 89-7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 38 ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR OPERATION AND USE OF CITY PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT OF REGULATIONS, VARIANCE, PENALTY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SAVINGS CLAUSE, AND EFFECTIVE DATE," WHICH ORDINANCE WAS PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLOCH ON JUNE 4, 1980, BY AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ARTICLE IV THEREOF PERTAINING TO HOURS OF OPERATION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1

That certain Ordinance No. 38 entitled "AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR OPERATION AND USE OF CITY PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT OF REGULATIONS, VARIANCE, PENALTY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SAVINGS CLAUSE, AND EFFECTIVE DATE", which Ordinance was passed by the City Council of the City of Woodloch, Texas, on June 4, 1980, is hereby amended in Section 1 of Article IV thereof, so that such Section shall hereafter read as follows:

IV.

HOURS OF OPERATION

SECTION 1. Hours of Operation.

The Parks and Playgrounds shall be open daily during each year from the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. to 9:00 o'clock P.M. of any one day; and it shall be unlawful for any person, or persons (other than City personnel conducting City business therein), to occupy or be present in said Parks and Playgrounds during any hours in which the same are not open to the public.

Any section, or part of the Parks and Playgrounds may be declared closed to the public by the park Superintendent or city Council at any time and for any interval of time, either temporarily or at regular or stated intervals.

SECTION 2.

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisons of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3.

Whereas an emergency being in effect which threatens the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, necessitating that this Ordinance become effective at once and it is accordingly ordained that this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
