

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, all citizens of Montgomery County are taxed for County Government without regard to whether they reside within the incorporated boundaries of a General Law city; and

WHEREAS, County Commissioners' Court has adopted a policy to charge for all services rendered within the boundaries of General Law cities in Montgomery County, including costs for materials, labor and equipment; and

WHEREAS, these charges for services rendered to citizens of General Law cities within the County amount to DOUBLE TAXATION; and

WHEREAS, there are numerous services that the County could provide within the boundaries of General Law cities that benefit all of the citizens of Montgomery County, not just the residents of those General Law cities; and


WHEREAS, the City of WOODLOCH, in conjunction with other General Law cities within Montgomery County, believes that the policy of charging for services rendered by the County within General Law cities is an inappropriate attempt to raise revenue from taxpayer's already paying full taxes to the County and a misuse of power that is unfair to the citizens of the City of WOODLOCH, all of whom are also citizens and taxpayers of Montgomery County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of WOODLOCH asks the County Commissioners to rescind their decision of May \_\_\_\_, 1992, to charge cities for work done by the County, and agree to again provide services, as appropriate, under circumstances, including interlocal agreements or at no charge, as may from time to time be agreed upon between those entities and the individual County Commissioners, reinstating the policy in place before the aforementioned May \_\_\_\_, 1992 action.
