Motion was made by <u>Donald J. Nichols III</u>, seconded by <u>Laura Kessner</u>, that the following ordinance be passed:

ORDINANCE NO. 11082021-1

AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS; TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR AN ELECTED POSITION OF MAYOR, CITY COUNCIL ALDERMAN POSITION, FOR REPRESENTING THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, MUST BE BETWEEN THE AGE OF NO LESS THAN 25 YEARS OR MORE THAN 65 YEARS TO BE CONSIDERED ELIGIBLE FOR A POSITION ON THE ELECTION BALLOT; PROVIDING DEFINITIONS; AGE REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS THERETO; A RESIDING ELECTED OFFICIAL RUNNING UNOPOSED; REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE AFTER PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Woodloch believes that it is in the best interest of its residents, to imply an age bracket to best serve the town's residents, investments, and social demand of current and future political standings; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council further believes that it is in the best interest of its residents that anyone applying for an elected position within the Town of Woodloch be no less than 25 years of age and not to exceed 65 years of age during the said term of such office.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS THAT:

Election Requirements

The age of any person seeking an elected position of the Town of Woodloch, to include Mayor and City Council Alderman position shall be between the age of 25 years and 65 years, and not exceeding the required age limit of applied position on or before the date of election for the said position, unless currently sitting/occupying the said position.

Repealing Conflicting Ordinances

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby expressly repealed.

Effective Date

That this Ordinance and each section hereof shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication by the City Secretary.
