NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS, TEXAS, ADOPTING AND ACCEPTING THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 1143, VERNON'S REVISED CIVIL STATUTES OF THE STATE OF TEXAS.

WHEREAS, Article 1143, Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas, provides that in lieu of one year terms of office, the Board of Aldermen may provide by Ordinance for two year staggered terms of office for the Mayor and Aldermen:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS, TEXAS:

THAT the Town of Whispering Oaks, Texas, by and through its Board of Aldermen, does hereby adopt and accept the provisions of said Article 1143.
