

Motion was made by John Baker, seconded by

Rayma B. Causey, that the following Ordinance be passed:

NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE ORDERING A REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD APRIL 5, 1975, IN THE TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS, TEXAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THREE ALDERMEN AND A MARSHAL; DESIGNATING THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR HOLDING THE ELECTION; APPOINTING THE PRESIDING JUDGE, ALTERNATE PRESIDING JUDGE AND CLERK FOR ABSENTEE VOTING; PROVIDING THAT ALL QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING WITHIN THE LIMITS OF WHISPERING OAKS, TEXAS, SHALL BE ENTITLED TO VOTE; DIRECTING TOWN SECRETARY TO OBTAIN SUPPLIES, AND MAYOR TO ISSUE ALL NECESSARY ORDERS AND PROVIDING FOR RETURNS.

WHEREAS, the General Laws of the State of Texas pertaining to cities, towns and villages, provide that on the first Saturday in April, being April 5, 1975, there shall be held an election to elect the following officials for the Town:

Three (3) Aldermen (Places 1, 2 and 3)

One (1) Marshal

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of Texas provide that the Election Code of the State of Texas governs said election, and in order to comply therewith, an Order shall be passed establishing the procedure to be followed, and designating the voting place therefor:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS, TEXAS:

That all candidates desiring to run at the election to be held Saturday, April 5, 1975, for the above mentioned offices, shall file their application with the Town Secretary of the Town, at 2695 Whispering Oaks Lane, on or before thirty (30) days before the date of said election.

Louise Wilder is hereby appointed Presiding Judge, and Mary Linnehan as Alternate Presiding Judge.

The Presiding Judge shall appoint the necessary Clerks to assist her which shall not exceed 5 Clerks.

Karla Wolff is hereby appointed Clerk for absentee voting. The absentee voting for the above designated election shall be held at 2695 Whispering Oaks Lane, within said Town, and said place of absentee voting shall remain open for at least eight hours on each day for absentee voting which is not a Saturday, a Sunday, or an official State Holiday, beginning on the 20th day and continuing through the 4th day preceding the date of said election.

That said place of voting shall remain open between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M. on each day for said absentee voting.

That the Secretary shall post in her office the names of all candidates who have filed their applications in accordance with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance, and said names shall be posted at a conspicuous place in said office for at least 10 days before the Secretary orders the same to be printed on the ballot for said election.

That the election shall be held at 2677 Whispering Oaks, Lane, Whispering Oaks, Texas, Saturday, April 5, 1975.

That the polls will be open at 7:00 A. M. and close at 7:00 P. M.

That the Town Secretary is hereby authorized and instructed to provide and furnish all necessary election supplies to conduct said election.

That the Mayor shall issue all necessary orders, writs and notices for said election and returns of said election shall be made to the Town Secretary immediately after the closing of the polls, all as required by the Election Laws.
