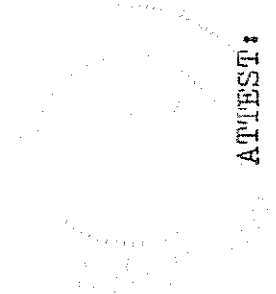
ORDINANCE SETTING TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 1976

Whereas, the Mayor has recommended a tax rate of Sixty-Five (65) Cents on the one hundred Dollar valuation of all property of every kind and character appearing on the Town of Whispering Oaks Tax Rolls for the year 1976, which is required to raise funds for interest and sinking fund requirements:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS, TEXAS:

That the tax rate be and the same is hereby set as Sixty-Five (65) Cents on the one hundred dollar valuation of all property of every kind and character placed on Tax Rolls of the Town of Whispering Oaks, Texas, for the year 1976.
