

Motion was made by Tom Wolff, seconded by James P. Lout,
that the following Ordinance be passed:

NO. 13A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION III, OF ORDINANCE NO. 13,
PASSED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS,
TEXAS, (NOW TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS), ON OCTOBER 1, 1975,
ESTABLISHING CHARGE FOR NEW RESIDENCE WATER SERVICE
CONNECTION; ADDING AMENDMENT ESTABLISHING CHARGE FOR
NON-RESIDENT CONNECTIONS; PROVIDING CHARGE FOR COMMERCIAL
AND BUSINESS SERVICE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT,
AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH,
TEXAS:

That Section III, of Ordinance No. 13, passed by the
Town Council of the Town of Whispering Oaks, Texas, (now Town
of Woodloch, Texas) on October 1, 1975, be amended to hereafter
read as follows:

"SECTION III.
NEW RESIDENCES

(1) That any new residence or any type of construc-
tion requiring a water service connection shall pay the sum of
Three Hundred and No/100 (\$300.00) Dollars therefor, plus the
Twenty-Five and No/100 (\$25.00) Dollars deposit heretofore set
out."

That the following sub-sections be added to Section
III, as follows:

"NON-RESIDENT CONNECTIONS

(2) That any property or improvement located outside
of the Town limits, desiring a water service connection, which
has been approved by the Town Council, shall pay the sum of Six
Hundred and No/100 (\$600.00) Dollars therefor, plus all addi-
tional charges, based on a statement furnished, plus Twenty-
Five and No/100 (\$25.00) Dollars deposit.


SERVICE CHARGE TO COMMERCIAL AND
BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS

(3) That the charge for water service to all com-
mercial and business establishments shall be Twenty-Five and
No/100 (\$25.00) Dollars per month per connection."

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

The effective date of this Amended Ordinance shall be as of the date of passage.


