NO. 13B

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION VII, OF ORDINANCE NO. 13, PASSED BY THE TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS, TEXAS, (NOW TOWN OF WOODLOCH) ON OCTOBER 1, 1975; ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF WATER SERVICE; APPLICABLE TO ALL RESIDENTS AND NON-RESIDENTS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT, AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS:

THAT Section VII, of Ordinance No. 13, passed by the Town Council of the Town of Whispering Oaks, Texas, (now Town of Woodloch, Texas) on October 1, 1975, be amended to hereafter read as follows:

"SECTION VII.

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

That water and water service to any consumer whose account is more than thirty (30) days delinquent shall be disconnected and cut off, and the charge therefor shall be Two and No/100 (\$2.00) Dollars, plus all costs incurred by Town in making said disconnect.

That in addition to the charges herein set out, there shall be charged and collected the sum of Eight and No/100 (\$8.00) Dollars for reconnection and resumption of such service to said consumer.

That the provisions aforesaid shall be applicable to resident and non-resident consumers."

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
