that the following Ordinance be passed:

NO. 22

FIREWORKS ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE AND DISCHARGE OF
FIREWORKS, TORPEDOES, ROCKETS, ETC., WITHIN THE
TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS, TEXAS, REPEALING ALL
ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHISPERING
OAKS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

No person, firm, company, corporation or association
shall cast, throw, shoot or fire any squib, rocket, cracker,
torpedo, grenade, or any other type or kind of combustible
fireworks in the Town of Whispering Oaks, Texas.

SECTION 2.

No person, firm, company, corporation or association
shall exhibit or have in his possession, with intent to give
away or sell or offer for sale or sell within the corporate
limits of the Town of Whispering Oaks, Texas, any squib, rocket,
cracker, torpedo, grenade, or any other type or kind of com-
bustible fireworks in the Town of Whispering Oaks.

SECTION 3.

Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to
apply to the sale, storage or use of flashlight composition
by photographers or dealers in photographic supplies or prevent
any public or private demonstration or display of fireworks
of any kind if conducted under proper police supervision after
application made and permit issued by the Town Council of the
Town of Whispering Oaks, for such demonstration. Said permit
shall not be granted unless such demonstration or display
shall be of such a character, and so located, discharged or
fired, as in the opinion of the Town Fire Marshal after proper
inspection, shall not be hazardous to property or endanger
any person or persons.

SECTION 4.

Any person, firm, corporation, company or association who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, or suffer or allow the same to be violated shall upon conviction therefor be subject to a fine of not more than One Hundred and No/100 (\$100.00) Dollars.

SECTION 5.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6.

The importance of this Ordinance and its intent and purpose being declared to be for the benefit of the citizens and property owners in the Town of Whispering Oaks, Texas, constitute an emergency, and an imperative public necessity that it be declared to be an emergency measure and that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and it is so enacted.


