

Motion was made by Lloyd Shenberger, seconded by John Stefan,  
that the following Ordinance be passed:

NO. 49

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS, AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 21, BY ADDING SECTIONS 1-A AND 1-B TO  
ARTICLE XI; PROVIDING FOR MINIMUM FINES FOR CERTAIN  
OFFENSES; PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF UPON A PLEA  
OF GUILTY; PROVIDING FOR COURT APPEARANCE IN INSTANCES  
OF TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN  
CONFLICT, AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
WOODLOCH, TEXAS:

THAT Ordinance No. 21, as passed by the City Council  
on July 6, 1977, be and it is hereby amended, by adding Sections  
1-A and 1-B, to Article XI thereof, establishing minimum fines  
for violation of certain Traffic Ordinance of the City of  
Woodloch, Texas, and traffic laws of the State of Texas, es-  
tablishing method of payment thereof where guilty plea is  
entered, and requiring court appearance by defendant where of-  
fense arose in connection with a traffic accident, to read as  
follows:

"SECTION 1-A.

The following minimum fines are hereby established  
for the offenses hereinafter indicated:

DESCRIPTION	MINIMUM FINE
Running Stop Sign. . . . .	\$ 27.50
Speeding . . . . .	27.50
No Operator's License. . . . .	27.50
No Operator's License on Demand. . . . .	18.50
Expired Drivers License. . . . .	27.50
Fictitious Drivers License . . . . .	50.00
No Vehicle License . . . . .	27.50
Fictitious Vehicle License . . . . .	50.00
Defective Exhaust System . . . . .	27.50
Defective Lights and Equipment . . . . .	18.50
Defective Brakes . . . . .	27.50

DESCRIPTION	MINIMUM FINE
No Valid MVI Sticker . . . . .	\$ 27.50
Passing School Bus Loading or Unloading . . . . .	50.00
Reckless Driving . . . . .	50.00
Failure to Appear in Court or Enter Plea . . . . .	50.00"

"SECTION 1-B.


All persons charged with any of the traffic offenses set out in Section 1-A above, who desire to enter a plea of guilty to the offense charged, may do so by mailing minimum fine therefor to the City of Woodloch, c/o Municipal Judge; provided, however, that with respect to any violation arising out of or in connection with a motor vehicle collision or other accident, the defendant is required to formally enter his appearance in person before the Municipal Judge."

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances and motions in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.


That this Ordinance shall be posted in three places within the City, and shall become effective on the date thereof.
