ORDINANCE SETTING TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 1981

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended a tax rate of
fifty five (55¢) Cents on the one hundred dollar valuation
of all property of every kind and character appearing on the
City of Woodloch Tax Rolls for the year 1981, which is required
to raise the funds needed for its Budget heretofore adopted,
to be used for interest and sinking fund:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS:

THAT the tax rate be and the same is hereby set at
fifty five (55¢) Cents on the one hundred dollar valuation
of all property of every kind and character placed on the Tax
Rolls of the City of Woodloch, Texas, for the year 1981.
