(Motion was made by Clayd Schenberger, seconded by Raymond Lovelock, that the following Ordinance be passed:)

ORDINANCE NO. 53

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND LEVYING MUNICIPAL AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS FOR THE YEAR 1982 AND FOR EACH YEAR THEREAFTER UNTIL OTHERWISE PROVIDED; AND DIRECTING THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the tax for the year 1982, hereinafter levied for current expenses of the City and the general improvements of the City and its property must be levied to provide the revenues required for the budget of the ensuing year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further finds that the taxes for the year 1982, hereinafter levied therefor are necessary for municipal purposes during the ensuing year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE WOODLOCH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1:

For the current expenses of the City of Woodloch, Texas, and for the general improvement and welfare of the City, there is hereby levied and ordered to be assessed and collected for the year 1982, and for each year thereafter until it be otherwise provided and ordained on all property situated within the limits of the City of Woodloch, Texas, and not exempt from taxation by valid laws, an ad valorem tax at the rate of \$.42 on the \$100.00 evaluation of such property.
