

ORDINANCE NO. 89-2

ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE DENYING GULF STATES UTILITIES COMPANY THE AUTHORITY TO PLACE INTO EFFECT THE PROPOSED REVISED TARIFFS AND SCHEDULES FILED WITH THE CITY ON OR ABOUT MARCH 21, 1989.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS.

Section 1

On or about March 21, 1989, Gulf States Utilities Company filed a Petition and Statement of Intent to Change Rates and proposed new tariffs with the City of Woodloch, Texas (hereinafter "the City").

Section 2

After review of these matters by the City Council, Gulf States Utilities Company is hereby DENIED the authority to place into effect the proposed revised tariffs and schedules filed with the City on or about March 21, 1989.

Section 3

Nothing contained in this ordinance shall be construed in any manner now or hereafter limiting or modifying the right and power of the City under the law to regulate the rates charged by Gulf States Utilities Company for its services within the City.
