ORDINANCE NO. 91-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 89-12 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING NEW RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER RATES; PROVIDING FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE FOR FAILURE TO PAY BILLS; PENALTY ON DELINQUENT BILLS; RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL INSPECTION FEES; RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER TAP CHARGES RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL STANDBY CHANGES; RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL UTILITY DEPOSITS; TITLE TO METERS, TAMPERING, MAINTENANCE AND SETTING OF SAME; DITCH DEPOSIT; UNAUTHORIZED CONNECTIONS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT; SAVINGS CLAUSE AND EFFECTIVE DATE", WHICH ORDINANCE WAS PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS ON November 14, 1989, BY AMENDING SECTION 2 THEREOF PERTAINING TO RESIDENTIAL WATER SURCHARGES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1

That certain Ordinance No. 89-12 entitled "AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING NEW RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER RATES; PROVIDING FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE FOR FAILURE TO PAY BILLS; PENALTY ON DELINQUENT BILLS; RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL INSPECTION FEES; RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER TAP CHARGES RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL STANDBY CHANGES; RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL UTILITY DEPOSITS; TITLE TO METERS, TAMPERING, MAINTENANCE AND SETTING OF SAME; DITCH DEPOSIT; UNAUTHORIZED CONNECTIONS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT; SAVINGS CLAUSE AND EFFECTIVE DATE", which Ordinance was passed by the City Council of the City of Woodloch, Texas, on November 14, 1989, is hereby amended in Section 2 thereof, by adding Subsection (5) so that such addition shall read as follows:

Section 2.(5)

Effective July 1, 1991, there is hereby added a monthly surcharge to each water bill the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00) which shall be in force through June of 1992 and beginning in

July of 1992 there shall be added an additional ten dollars (\$10.00) to each water bill which shall be in force until June of 1994 at which time such surcharges shall terminate. These surcharges shall apply to service both inside and outside the City. All funds collected from such surcharge shall be placed into an interest bearing account and used to consolidate and improve the existing waste water plants as directed by City Council.

SECTION 2

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3

Whereas an emergency being in effect which threatens the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, necessitating that this Ordinance become effective at once and it is accordingly ordained that this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
