ORDINANCE NO. 92-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 89-12 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING NEW RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER RATES; PROVIDING FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE FOR FAILURE TO PAY BILLS; PENALTY ON DELINQUENT BILLS; RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL INSPECTION FEES; RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER TAP CHARGES RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL STANDBY CHARGES; RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL UTILITY DEPOSITS; TITLE TO METERS, TAMPERING, MAINTENANCE AND SETTING OF SAME; DITCH DEPOSIT; UNAUTHORIZED CONNECTIONS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT; SAVINGS CLAUSE AND EFFECTIVE DATE", WHICH ORDINANCE WAS PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS ON NOVEMBER 14, 1989, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 91-1 WHICH WAS PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS, ON JUNE 18, 1991, BY AMENDING SECTION 2 THEREOF PERTAINING TO RESIDENTIAL WATER SURCHARGES; AND SECTION 18 THEREOF PERTAINING TO RESIDENTIAL SEWER SERVICE REQUEST AND TAP INSPECTION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1

That certain Ordinance No. 89-12 entitled "AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING NEW RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER RATES; PROVIDING FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE FOR FAILURE TO PAY BILLS; PENALTY ON DELINQUENT BILLS; RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL INSPECTION FEES; RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER TAP CHARGES RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL STANDBY CHARGES; RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL UTILITY DEPOSITS; TITLE TO METERS, TAMPERING, MAINTENANCE AND SETTING OF SAME; DITCH DEPOSIT; UNAUTHORIZED CONNECTIONS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT; SAVINGS CLAUSE AND EFFECTIVE DATE", which Ordinance was passed by the City Council of the City of Woodloch, Texas, on November 14, 1989, as amended by Ordinance 91-1 passed by the City Council of the City of Woodloch Texas on June 18, 1991 is hereby amended in Section 2 thereof, by changing Subsection (5) and by changing Section 18 so that such additions shall read as follows:

Section 2.(5)

Effective July 1, 1991, there is hereby added a monthly

surchARGE to each water bill the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00) which shall be in force through June of 1993 at which time such surcharge shall terminate. This surcharge shall apply to service both inside and outside the City. All funds collected from such surcharge shall be placed into an interest bearing account and used to construct a new waste water plant as directed by City Council.

SECTION 18

Every person requesting sewer service from the City shall so notify the City's Operator. After the notification, the City's Operator shall make the tap on the City's sewer line. All connections must conform to the "Rules and Regulations Governing Sewer House Lines and Sewer Connection for the Town of Woodloch" as adopted by the City Council, and as same may, from time to time, be amended. The City hereby sets a sewer tap fee equal to the actual cost of the tap plus an addition sum equal to 15% of the actual costs.

SECTION 2

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3

Whereas an emergency being in effect which threatens the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, necessitating that this Ordinance become effective at once and it is accordingly ordained that this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
