

Motion was made by R. ADAMS, seconded by J. LOUET that the following Ordinance be passed:

No. 93-1

AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS ("CITY"), PRESCRIBING A FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON OCTOBER 1 AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30 OF EACH YEAR COMMENCING ON OCTOBER 1, 1993; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH;

WHEREAS, the Town of Woodloch is authorized by the provisions of Subchapter C of Section 1, Chapter 101, Local Government Code to prescribe the fiscal year of the municipality and,

WHEREAS, the City council of the city finds that it would be in the best interest of the Citizens of Woodloch to adopt a fiscal year beginning on October 1 of each year; and,

WHEREAS, after due consideration, City Council is of the opinion that it will be beneficial in financial planning and budgeting to operate the business of the City on a fiscal year basis beginning on October 1 of each and to operate on a short three (3) month budget for the period July 1, 1993 through September 30, 1993.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS;

I.

#### ADOPTION

1. The fiscal year of the City shall hereafter be the year commencing on October 1 of each year beginning on October 1, 1993 and ending on September 30 of each year hereafter.
2. The City shall operate on a short three (3) month budget for the period July 1, 1993 through September 30, 1993 and thereafter commence its new fiscal year.

II.

REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

III.

SAVINGS CLAUSE

That if any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
