EXCESSIVE FORCE RESOLUTION

A resolution for the Town of Woodloch establishing a policy regarding the use of excessive force during nonviolent civil rights demonstrations, including physically barring entrance to a facility or location which is the subject of such demonstration, and confirming the Town's intent to enforce this policy:

ARTICLE I


Section 1: It is the policy of the Town of Woodloch to prohibit the use of excessive force by the law enforcement agencies within its jurisdiction against any individual engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations. The Town also prohibits the physical barring of any entrance to, or exit from a facility within its jurisdiction, which is the subject of such demonstrations.


ARTICLE II

Section 1: It is the policy of the Town to enforce this policy the full extent allowed by law.
