## When to come?

June 17-21, 2024 Camp starts at 2:00 pm on the 17th. Camp ends at 9:00 am on the 21st.

## Who can come?

Any student who has completed 6th-12th grade by camp.

## How much?

The cost is \$190 per camper. A \$40.00 deposit is required with the application. The applications are due by June 5th. The balance of \$150.00 is due at camp. Please mail camp form to: Liberty Church, 2732 Old Rocky Ridge Road, Birmingham AL 35216. Make checks payable to Liberty Church.

## What to Bring?

Your Bible, your own linens, pillow, towels, soap, deodorant, insect repellent, sunscreen, and maybe a flashlight. Cabins are air-conditioned. However you may bring a small fan if you desire. Campers will need extra spending money for snacks. Snacks run around \$.50 each to \$1.00 each. Drinks are \$1.00. You will need enough clothes to last for the entire week of camp. Please remember that during night chapel, guys should wear pants or long shorts, and girls should wear pants, capris or skirts.

## What to Wear?

Both guys and girls should wear clothing that is modest and in good taste. All shorts must be mid-thigh or longer. All swimsuits, guys and girls, should be modest and in good taste. All campers are required to wear a colored T-shirt cover-up when swimming. (Tankinis are allowed.) These guidelines will be enforced by your cabin leaders and if you are dressed inappropriately, you will be expected to change into something more appropriate. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and great attitudes regarding the type of clothing you wear during camp.

## What NOT to Bring

No alcohol, tobacco products, or profanity should be used while attending summer camp. Campers are asked to leave all CD players, MP3 players, DVD players and fireworks at home. Cell phones can be used at night time ONLY in your cabins.

## What will you do?
