Where do we start? Relationships!

- Just show up <u>regularly</u>!
- What it looks like...

"<u>Relationships</u> enhance an experience beyond expectations. They add an enriching aspect to an event. In kidmin, I can host a ton of great events...including the weekend services. But if I want to make them greater, richer, more enticing...there must be a relational connection. ... And the best way to know someone is to be consistently present in their lives. Orange calls that "Showing up <u>Predictably.</u>"

- Wisdom: "Knowledge of what is true or right coupled with just judgment as to action."
- "Our kids are going to grow up and have to make thousands of decisions in their lives. Based on the definition, in order to act wisely a person needs to know what is true or right, and have just judgment."


How Wisdom Fits:

- The biographies in the handbooks help the children see how God worked in the lives of people in the past.
- "What I need to remember..." at the end of the biographies helps them understand and gives the leaders talking points.
- Verses they memorize at the end of the biographies help stress the truth learned.
- Take time to make sure they understand!

• The *Sparks Activity CD* has an activity sheet that corresponds to each biography (plus other fun stuff).


• The Bible Timeline in the clubber handbook helps put the event in perspective.



Related to Wisdom: Bible Literacy


- Print character ID Card (found on the handbook CD)
