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SYNOPSIS

Judge Eckerle and Sheriff John Aubrey don't want me in the courtrooms to witness the racketeering of many cases in Jefferson County district courts. These are fake cases prosecuted without the county attorneys filing criminal Complaints in court under **RCr 2.02**. This means **no criminal charges are actually filed** against the would-be defendants, but while Court Clerk David Nicholson issues case numbers on these bogus cases. This has been done in five cases that I know of, including 09-F-013580, 12-F-06759, 13-M-05776, 12-F-07230, and 13-M-01390. I was victimized in 09-F-013580.

The purpose of this racket is to extract fines, fees, and court-costs from

IV. ALLEGATIONS AND STATEMENT OF FACTS:

In Jefferson County, court officials, with collaboration from the Jefferson County sheriff and Louisville Metro Police Depts. (LMPD), are running a racketeering scheme of initiating criminal cases without the county attorney filing the criminal Complaints required by RCr 2.02. This is being done in two cases against Connie Marshall (12-F-007230 & 13-M-001390). No complaint means that no formal criminal charges are filed against Ms. Marshall, but the court clerks are assigning case numbers as though these cases are real.

The judge, Sean Delahanty, is on record stating LMPD citations may be the complaints for cases (4-9-2013 & 5-23-2013), but that's impossible. Pursuant to RCr 2.02 (KY Rules of Criminal Procedures), a Complaint must be signed-off on the facts in Court by the party prosecuting the case, the Commonwealth [of Kentucky], as represented by the county **OR**

ALLEGATIONS AND STATEMENT OF FACTS (continued):

Commonwealth attorney. LMPD does not prosecute these cases, but is merely a witness for the Commonwealth.

Ms. Marshall has been to court at least **10 times** with **NO WITNESSES** showing-up for the Commonwealth (**6-29-2012, 7-9-2012, 7-14-2012, 7-26-2012, 11-14-2012, 1-29-2013, 3-22-2013, 4-9-2013, 3-27-2013, and 5-23-2013**). With no witnesses, and with no formal charges filed **OR** lawful arraignment processed under RCr 2.02, Delahanty is still ignoring Ms. Marshall's motions to dismiss these fraudulent cases.

Ms. Marshall was forced to fire her attorney, Robert Schaad, when he refused to address these atrocities. Now, **Ms. Marshall is on her own** trying to fight-off the unconstitutional shennanigans of Delahanty. Sadly, Attorney Schaad works for Legal Aid. These unacceptable human rights violations being perpetrated in America cannot be tolerated. They must be quashed!

MOTIVE FOR THIS RACKET: These unlawful cases are perpetrated to extract fees, fines and court costs from the victims. Cases that are typically "domestic disputes," "arguments with authorities" (such as Ms. Marshall's two cases) **OR** "outright encounters of harassment by LMPD" are coverted to LMPD citations as criminal charges. But the Jefferson county attorneys do not file Complaints under RCr 2.02 to avoid validating and signing-off on bogus evidence that do not warrant criminal charges. Again, without RCr 2.02's Complaint signed in Court by the county attorney, no formal charges are actually filed against these victims as "would-be defendants."

I was unlawfully prosecuted in 09-F-013580 in 2011 where no Complaint was filed by assist. county attorney Ingrid Gieser (**Judge Anne Haynie**). And, Keith Ponder is the victim in cases 12-F-06759 and 13-M-05776, again perpetrated by Ingrid Geiser (and **Judge Donald Armstrong**) where no Complaints were filed against him.
