The Wellness Fair brings interactive participation with dozens of service providers in the following 7 health dimensions: Medical, mental, dental, vision, safety, healthy foods, and active living. Raffle of bikes and health baskets between fitness and service demonstrators, healthy food vendors and free snacks, music, and more.
