Happy New Year! There Is Something New Under the Sun!

Now and then someone will ask what I read for devotional times. I have several sources including the Oswald Chambers classic *My Utmost for His Highest*, an Anglican prayer book adapted by Robert Webber for easier use by the modern reader, and a number of daily reading sources including a new-to-me volume by N.T. Wright.

Dear friends gifted me with a book of daily meditations by Henri J.M. Nouwen entitled *You Are the Beloved*, and I think I'm going to really like it. Let me share with you some thoughts from its January 1 entry:

We must learn to live each day, each hour, yes, each minute as a new beginning, as a unique opportunity to make everything new. ... The problem is that to allow our past, which becomes longer and longer each year, to say to us: "You know it all; you have seen it all, be realistic; the future will just be a repeat of the past. Try to survive it as best you can." There are many cunning foxes jumping on our shoulders and whispering in our ears the great lie: "There is nothing new under the sun... don't let yourself be fooled."

When we listen to these foxes, they eventually prove themselves right: our new year, our new day, our new hour become flat, boring, dull, and without anything new.

So what are we to do? First, we must send the foxes back to where they belong in their foxholes. And then we must open our minds and our hearts to the voice that resounds through the valleys and hills of our life saying: "Let me show you where I live among

my people. My name is 'God-with-you.' I will wipe all the tears from your eyes; There will be no more death or morning or sadness. The world of the past has gone" (Revelation 21: 2-5).

It is a fitting thought as, together, we approach the topic of hope in early 2024. Finding new potential in the life God gives us through Jesus Christ is crucial to our growth in depth and breadth at Sunset Hills. It is a new year with new things joining the familiar. Let's not despise the power of small beginnings. Let's nurture it.

The prayer meeting for January will be on January 8^{th,} at 6:00 p.m. at the church instead of the usual first Monday of the month, due to New Years Day. Guest leaders for January will be Joan and Gary Peterson. It's about Hope!

A reminder to those who might be new at attending Sunset Hills:

There are two boxes in the Narthex. One is for confidential prayer requests, and one is for suggestions or comments. The Confidential Prayer Box is a place for prayers that are private and confidential. They are not looked at or read, and they will be burned or shredded after being prayed over. The Suggestions and Comments Box is just to the right of the Confidential Praises and Prayers box. Both boxes are hanging on the wall just beside the bulletin board over by the entrance to the women's restroom (to the right of the coffee/snack bar.)

Volunteers are needed to help with projected activities and projects of the Prayer Ministry. Projects that could use your help as coordinators and/or one time volunteers: Prayer Chain Coordinator; Leader of a Monthly Prayer meeting (first Monday evening of the month); "Sitting With God" Prayer Service (every 3-4 months if possible); Baptist World Day of Prayer -International Women's is the first Friday in March and is celebrated annually in over 170 countries; National Day of Prayer – Annual day of observance held on the first Thursday of May, designated by the US Congress when people are asked to "turn to God in prayer and meditation." Special emphasis prayer gathering(s) and/or prayer study ideas.



Business:

Safety and Security: Rev. Jason Workman

• Lighting downstairs has been fixed. Jason is talking to all groups that use the church to make sure that they are cleaning up after themselves and that all doors inside are locked when they leave. Looking at changing our current internet provider.

Music and Worship: Rev. Jason Workman

• New Years Eve service is planned and just looking for scripture readers. Looking at a sound system to use outdoors for when we have service outside.

Pastor/Staff Relations: Ron Reed

- In November we initially had four people expressing interest in the Church Custodian position. Two did not follow up. Two were interviewed but one felt they needed more pay than Maverick was receiving, which was at the top of the pay scale locally and regionally. The other was Ashley Rhedin. Both had past experience.
- Our PSRM Committee was informed about the two who interviewed and agreed that Ashely would be good for the position. Ron met with her to complete the employment agreement, and later for orientation. She will work 3 hours per week on either Thursday or Friday early evenings. Doug Larsen and Ron Reed met on December 9 to enter her into the payroll system.

• Terry will meet with Rick Wheatley to discuss outreach ideas.

• Going forward someone different will lead the prayer meetings held once a month. Going to put reminders in the newsletter and bulletin for *Chosen* Study starting January 7 in Adult Sunday School Class.

Ministry Council:

- Plan January Annual report/meeting after church January 7 will be held in sanctuary
- Review Pastor's plans and agenda for the coming year. He has a list of seven areas that he would like to work on and improve.

Ron was asked to inform them of all the Stewardship Ministry's responsibilities, and relative details of those responsibilities. It was shared that no one person wants to do all of this. Our goal is to meet in January to reorganize the Stewardship Ministry into Stewardship sub-ministries, with volunteer leaders and team members for each. The Ministry Leader will work with the sub-ministry leaders to better manage the responsibilities and represent the ministry while serving on the Ministry Council.
- It has been suggested that the Safety and Security Ministry should have the building's alarm system and security code responsibilities.
