CALL TO ORDER – Diane Workman PASTOR WORD – Rev. Steve Wamberg FINANCIAL REPORT – Doug Larson MINSTRY UPDATES – Diane Workman

We are a strong healthy church. The Pastoral search committee is currently talking with 2 candidates, and they are moving onto the next steps. Our Ministry Council has been busy revising the bylaws. Each ministry has also been busy and doing amazing work. Here is a recap of some of their accomplishments and endeavors so far this year.

- Discipleship 23 kids attended VBS, and we have had 2 youth attend camp this summer.
 We have 3 active Sunday school classes led by LaShawnda Woods, Ron Reed and Joy
 Okoruwa. There is a pastor-led bible study every Wednesday evening. Jason Workman is
 leading a new, short-term bible study on Thursday evenings. There is a weekly online
 men's group and a women's mentoring group that meets twice monthly.
- Terry Anderson has agreed to lead Missions and Outreach. We are currently collecting backpacks and supplies for Pine Elementary, which we hope to be more active with this year. Rick Wheatley is leading our yearly mission offerings.
- Ron Reed is leading the Pastoral/Staff Relations Ministry team. They are supporting our Pastor and church staff.
- Dot North is leading our Prayer Ministry. She established the prayer box and suggestion box in the narthex. She has led the prayer time "Sitting with God."
- We welcome Amber Dale as the leader for the Shepherding Ministry. The meal ministry is available for members who could use a little help. She has a team of warriors caring for our members/shut-ins, etc.
- Jason Workman is leading the Worship Ministry. We, as a church, raised funds for a new drum set. Jason Rich is working on sound issues. Please give patience to these people. If you experience a problem with online sound, please just email the church as Jason is not always there running the sound board.
- Jason Workman is also the leader of Safety/Security. They hold training every month.
- Stewardship is our largest and most complicated ministry. Ron Reed has continued to serve in this role as an interim. This is a multifaceted ministry with 3 parts. Building maintenance in and outside of the church is only a part of this ministry. It takes everyone to help. We had a spring clean up and this fall we will be announcing a date for the fall clean up. We are working on various maintenance issues on the grounds involving the parking lot, drainage issues, tree removal and stump removal. For those of you with a green thumb we will be exploring replacing some trees next spring.

All of our ministries have opportunities. The more involved everyone is, the stronger we will be at doing God's work. If you have an interest in serving, please contact one of the leaders. There are all kinds of opportunities to serve.

Devotion and Prayer: Rev. Steve Wamberg – Colossians 3:23-24 Monthly Treasurer Report: Doug Larsen – Working on pledge cards and getting ready to hand/mail out.

Business:

Pastor Search Committee: We have a candidate and are in negotiations. A meet and greet date and announcement coming soon. The goal is to vote in October. We need at least 25% of members in attendance and a three-fourths majority vote. Notification will be at least 2 weeks prior to vote.

Safety/Security: Rev. Jason Workman – Discussed security concerns with members at the church after hours. There has been some suspicious activity in our parking lot.

Music and Worship: Rev. Jason Workman – Terri Rich is organizing the décor for the sanctuary. The team is working on software problems. Outdoor service is to be on September 10 (rain date September 24) with potluck to follow. Jason to communicate to Denise regarding publicizing service and potluck. Women's Sunday potentially on September 17. Jason will discuss with the team regarding service plans.

Pastor/Staff Relations: Ron Reed – Evaluation forms reviewed and finalized. Still working on Pastoral evaluation form.

Prayer: No updates.

Shepherding: Amber Dale – Shut in visits were done this month. A member of our congregation needs a car. If you have one available or know of someone who can donate or purchase one, let Jason Workman know. A nursery meeting will be held after the worship service on Sunday, August 27.

Missions/Outreach: Backpack Sunday and ALS Walk were successful. We sent mailings to VBS kids to say hi and stay in touch. Terry has a contact at Pine elementary and delivered the backpacks. October 29 – Trunk or Treat; October/November – Operation Christmas Child Shoebox Collection (Cheryl Arnold and Carol McCormick); November/December – Angel Tree (Pam Hamlin, LaShawnda Woods, Jean Larsen, Jacque McDuffie). A new daycare is being built in our community and they asked if they could use our back parking lot for their private trunk or treat. Jason will be on site during their event. Probation officers are using the church for training on August 28 and 29.

Ministry Council:

• Review the by-laws; proposed revisions were handed out. The ministry council will vote on revisions at the September 18 meeting and will present proposed changes to the congregation for a final vote. Proposed revisions will be available 3 weeks prior to congregational vote. There will be a Q&A available on November 5 after the worship service.

- Leadership training (build teams, lead teams and maintain teams). Plan for change. Four meetings approximately 1.5 2 hours each. First meeting on September 11 at 6:00 p.m. For ministry council members and open to all who would like to investigate being a leader.
- Discipleship: Vacant
 - ♦ Colossians 3 Communities Bible Study taking place Thursday evenings.
 - Need to look for a new VBS leader. LaShawnda has stepped down as the VBS leader.
- Stewardship: Vacant
 - Lighting the playground Proposed that we replace the broken light and upgrade the front light to LED.
 - ♦ Erosion problem in northeast lawn AJ Landscape proposed to cover and replace a 10-foot section and seed to protect washout. Jason motioned and Amber 2nd motioned.
 - Parking lot crack repair and joint repair Jason motioned, and Doug 2nd motioned.
 - Dead Tree removal on southwest corner Safety concerns with electrical lines and erosion on the hill at the base of the tree. Jason motioned and Doug 2nd motioned. Steve Bottum has been working on the erosion problem on the east side of the front drive.

A Safety and Assurance Campaign will be brought forth to the church to help with the projected cost of \$8,450.00. All the projects were motioned and voted to go ahead with plans.
