Course Descriptions

1075 The Synoptic Gospels (COPP Phase 2)

Focus on the Synoptic Gospels – Matthew, Mark, and Luke. Students will study the life and ministry of Jesus Christ as portrayed by these three writers. Through this comparative study, students will gain more comprehensive understanding of Jesus' ministry.

1089 Survey of Romans (COPP Phase 3)

Engage in an overview of major issues presented in Paul's doctrinal letter to the Roman Christians. Students will come to recognize each doctrinal truth presented in the book.

3008 Theology and History of Christianity (COPP Phase 2)

Outline the development of the Christian movement from the beginning of Jesus' ministry on Earth to present times. Focus on the history, theology, culture, and times that enable Christianity to develop and grow. Prominent persons who influenced the Christian movement will be identified.

4012 The Doctrine of The Holy Spirit (COPP Phase 2)

Study the process and work of the Holy Spirit. A thorough look at the corresponding doctrines that influence our understanding of the work of the Holy Spirit. Identify this doctrine of the church with a holistic understanding of salvation, with special emphases on justification, redemption, and sanctification.

8035 The African American Church and Social Justice (COPP Phase 4)

Investigate the lives, theology, and methods of the great servants of God who dedicated their lives in the struggle for liberation of people. Discuss the role of the African American church in the struggle for the liberation of people.

9004 Writing Techniques 1, (COPP Phase 2)

Focus on the Certificate of Progress Program writing requirements for Phase 2. Emphasis will be placed on the development of the skills necessary to complete the writing assignments. Skills that will be mastered range from the development of paragraphs/topic sentences to thesis-driven essays.

5012 Becoming an Effective Deacon *Seminar*

Assist the deacon in becoming aware of his biblical base. Ideas are given that will enable them to more effectively perform their duties and work harmoniously with the pastor and other church leaders.

5015 The Role of the Deaconess *Seminar*

Assist the deaconess in becoming aware of how she can effectively contribute to the work of the deacon. Students will learn Bible-based ideas that will enable them to be more proficient in their work.
