CRISIS MOMENT

Situation Presented Two Realities:

1. *Invited* Human Participation
2. *Required* Divine Intervention

HUMAN RESPONSE

1. The crisis *forced* the people to "*seek the LORD'S help*" and this was the secret to the reversal. (vs. 3)
2. The people gathered for an *all-out mobilization of worship* – this was a cry for God to become real in their situation.
3. The size of the crisis DEMANDED everyone's involvement

GOD'S RESPONSE

1. God reassured them that He was ***STILL*** Israel's God (vs. 17) - God gave them ***COMFORT*** in the crisis, before they every ***CONFRONTED*** the crisis.
2. The people's response to the crisis puts to test the spiritual presupposition that "***God will be found if we seek Him***" (15:2)

SCRIPTURAL PRESUPPOSITION

“Listen, all you people of Judah and Benjamin!
The Lord will stay with you as long as you stay with him! Whenever you seek him, you will find him. But if you abandon him, he will abandon you.”

(2 Chronicles 15:2 NLT)
