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| 1) Clos La Coutale Malbec | | 6/11 |
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2018 France: From well-sited vines in the Lot Valley in the southwest of France, this is always a sound benchmark wine for Cahors. The blend is 80% malbec with 20% merlot which creates the right balance. A wine that has structure yet roundness too, with ripe gentle brambly fruit and good length.

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| 2) Portlandia Pinot Noir | | 7/12 |
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2019 French: Dusty violet color. Aromas of spiced cherries, beet tart, pea sprouts, flaky pie crusts, and orange zest with a satiny, vibrant, dry-yet-fruity light-to-medium body and a graceful, interesting, medium-long blueberry pie, berry pavlova, and lemon supremes finish. A balanced and palate-pleasing Pinot Noir.

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| 3) Domaine du Pavillon de Chavannes, Côte de Brouilly | | 8/13 |
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2017 France: This is a very old school Beaujolais with a beautiful garnet color, beguiling aromatics that give off notes of violets, rose petals, and hints of oak. On the palate, a burst of refreshment with cherries, strawberries, and raspberries.

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| 4) Vitiano Falesco Blend | 34% Merlot, 33% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Sangiovese | 5/10 |
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2016 Italy: A wine that presents itself with magnificent appearance in its intense and deep ruby color, important and solid in its vast organoleptic outfit. High in the polyphenolic heritage that blends harmoniously with a fresh and tasty acidity, a versatile red, innovative in design and immediate and full enjoyment.

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| 5) Earthquake Cabernet Sauvignon | Wine Enthusiast 92 Points | 11/16 |
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2017 CA: Deep red in color, this Earthquake Cabernet opens with ripe black fruit and cinnamon on the nose. Full-bodied in texture with supple tannins, this wine is bursting with flavors of juicy blackberries, toasted marshmallow, and chocolate mocha.

6) Murrieta's Well Blend

6/11

35% Sauvignon Blanc, 31% Semillion, 15% Orange Muscat 11% Chardonnay,

2017 CA: Aromas of lime zest, green apple and basil, complemented by floral notes of spring blossoms and a gravelly minerality. As a barrel-fermented Sauvignon Blanc, with lees aging, this wine presents a layered and textured palate with a balancing acidity that maintains its varietal uniqueness.

7) San Felice 100% Vermintino

7/12

2019 Italy: The wine matures for about one month to develop aromatic complexity, and is then filtered and bottled, and finally ages 2 months in the bottle. Straw yellow colour. Aroma with notes of grapefruit, white flowers and cut grass. Fresh palate with a slightly citrus finish.

8) Six Hats Viognier

5/10

2017 South Africa : In the glass you'll see a pale green and light straw hue that's ultra refreshing to look at. Sublimely herby, green and crisp, this is the kind of wine you don't just sip, you gulp.

9) House Of Brown Chardonnay

8/13

2018 CA: Pineapple, starfruit, and guava with secondary notes of flowering star jasmine, orange blossoms, and traces of honeysuckle, lemon verbena, and meringue. Light, crisp, elegant, and juicy on the palate with a bright yet round mouthfeel.

10) Confidential Rosé

7/12

2019 CA: A rosé with a beautiful salmon colour and intense aromas of red fruits and flowers. In the palate it is elegant, balanced and reveals a great harmony between the fruit notes and the refreshing acidity. The finish is long and pleasant. A wine to drink on any occasion,

5/10

2017 Italy: Flavors Available - Peach , Pineapple and Strawberry and a regular flavored moscato (Blue)

12) Red Electra Moscato Sweet

5/10

2018 Ca: Bright violet color. Candied aromas and flavors of pear fruit cup and wrapped cherry candies with a clean, bright, sweet light body and a smooth, short finish with no oak flavor. A fruity quaffer to serve on ice.

13) Bariano Prosecco Extra Dry

5/10

Italy : Light and refreshing with soft fruit notes of lemon and peach, this wine is perfect for any bubble lover.

14) deMossa Sparkling Fruit Cocktail

5/10

Spain "Bright hazy golden yellow color. Aromas of freshly sliced oranges and pez candies with a glycerous, vibrant, spritzy, fruity medium body and a smooth, relaxed orange chewy candies, hay, dried apricots and pineapples. A fresh and fun mimosa for easy brunch fun. Made with valencia oranges 11% alc vol . Add a shot of vodka for an extra \$3.00.

15) Splash Sparkling White Wine
